LEE Why should you have all the fun? CHARLIE You shot a cop in Texas! LEE You just shot The President. CHARLIE

You shot a cop in Texas! It is not a competition.

LEE

Maybe I'll shoot you, too. I will tell them all it was you. You failed. You were hung over, or doped, or something. But you were something. And you killed The President in cold blood in sunlight by mistake. Do you realize what happens when you cross the G?

CHARLIE

The G? Settle down you little pissant traitor freak, or I will put you down like a sick dog.

LEE

Sorry Charlie. I'm sorry. You can trust me, I swear. We will get through this together. I just got scared with that damn cop.

CHARLIE

I can't trust you, Lee. I can't turn around without you doing some cockamammey-

(As Charlie turns around to the dead cop. POW. Lee cold cocks him with a sap.)

LEE

Well, you just had to see that one coming. I'm, uh, gonna be late for the movie. The matinee of War Is Hell starring Audie Murphy at The Texan Theater waits for no man. Gonna get me a good seat, catch as much as I can before-
